Subject: Regarding the issuance of a Recognition Certificate to schools under Rule 11, Sub-rule (4) of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011, for the purposes of Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009.

Reference: Proposal dated 29/11/2025 received from the Administrative Officer, Kalyan-Dombivli Municipal Corporation, Education Department, Kalyan, via Outward No. KDMC/Education Department/Sashi. /2025-26/1436.

With reference to your application dated 29/11/2025 and subsequent correspondence made with the school / communication / inspection of the school conducted in this regard.

I, Education Officer (Primary), Zilla Parishad Thane, am granting provisional recognition to Western Ridge International School, Survey No. 33/4/2/B, Katemanivali Kalyan (E), Tal. Kalyan, Dist. Thane (Name of the school with address) for a period of three years from **01/04/2025** to **31/03/2028**, for classes 1st to 6th. The above recognition is subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions.

1. The period of recognition shall not be extended, and there shall be no obligation, under any circumstances, to grant recognition or affiliation beyond Class 8.



2. The school shall comply with the provisions of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Appendix 1) and the Maharashtra Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011 (Appendix 2).
3. The school shall admit children belonging to weaker sections and disadvantaged groups in the neighborhood in Class 1, to the extent of at least 25% of the strength of that class, and provide free and compulsory education till the completion of elementary education. Provided further that this standard shall also be followed in the case of pre-primary classes.
4. For the children specified in Paragraph 3, the school shall receive reimbursement as per Section 12(2) of the Act. For the purpose of receiving such reimbursement, a separate bank account shall be provided to the school.
5. The institution/school shall not collect any capitation fee and shall not subject the child or his/her parents or guardians to any screening procedure.
6. No child shall be denied admission to the school for lack of proof of age, or on the grounds of religion, caste, race, place of birth, or any of these reasons.
7. (1) No child admitted to the school shall be held back in any class or expelled from the school until the completion of elementary education.

(2) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.

(3) No child shall be required to pass any Board examination until the completion of elementary education.

(4) Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down under Rule 23.



(5) Students with disabilities/special needs shall be included in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

(6) Teachers possessing the minimum qualifications as laid down under Section 23(1) of the Act shall be appointed. Provided further that, teachers who do not possess the minimum qualifications at the commencement of the Act shall be required to acquire such qualifications within a period of 5 years.

(7) Teachers shall perform their duties as specified under Section 24(1) of the Act.

(8) The school shall ensure that no teacher engages himself or herself in private tuition work.

8. The school shall follow the syllabus prepared on the basis of the curriculum formulated by the appropriate authority.

9. The school shall admit students in proportion to the facilities available in the school as prescribed under Section 19 of the Act.

10. The school shall comply with the norms and standards specified in Section 19 of the Act. The facilities available in the school at the time of the previous inspection were as follows: —

* Total Area of School Premises	:- 4,160 Sq.M.
* Total Built-up Area	:- 41,600 Sq. Ft.
* Area of Playground	:- 15,000 Sq. Ft.
* Number of Classrooms	:- 14
* Office-cum-Store-cum-Headmaster's Room	:- 6
* Separate toilets for boys and girls with adequate water for use and for keeping the toilets in a clean and hygienic condition	:- Available

11. No unrecognized classes or sections shall be conducted within the school premises or elsewhere in the name of the school.
12. The school building, other constructions, or the playground shall be used solely for the purposes of education and skill development.
13. The school is being run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) or a trust registered under the Mumbai Public Trusts Act, 1950.
14. The school is not run for the profit of any individual, group, or association of persons, or any other person.
15. The school accounts shall be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant, and proper accounting statements shall be prepared as per rules. A copy of each statement shall be sent to the District Education Officer (DEO) every year.
16. Please note that the recognition code allotted to your school is TH-KDMC-P-11. This code should be mentioned in all future correspondence with this office.
17. The school shall submit such reports and information as the Director of Education/District Education Officer may require from time to time, and shall comply with instructions issued by the Government or local authority to ensure continued fulfillment of recognition conditions or to remove deficiencies in the school's functioning.
18. The institution shall ensure the renewal of its registration, if any.
19. Other conditions as per Appendix 3 are attached herewith.
20. Regarding the proposal submitted by the Headmaster, Western Ridge International School, B/2/4/33, Survey No., Katemanivali, Kalyan (East), Taluka Kalyan, Dist. Thane, for obtaining the RTE Re-recognition Form No. 2: if any complaints arise regarding the submitted documents, or if any documents are found to be false or misleading, the RTE Re-recognition Form No. 2 issued by this office shall be considered cancelled.
